

# **2020 Fall Band Rehearsal, Performance Schedule & Safety Protocols**

**\*Do not attend rehearsals or performances if have Covid symptoms**

**Zero Hour Rehearsals (only during month of September)** - includes Virtual Pep Band members

- Tuesday and Wednesday mornings 7:15 AM
  - so both A & B students get one morning per week
- 9th grade Marching Band students who have seminar stay at Band through 1st hr.
  - If need seminar on a certain day for academic reason clear with Director in advance

**Evening Marching Band Rehearsal Schedule** (includes Virtual pep band students)

\*all students who expressed interest in being a part of the football game pep band group

**School Day Rehearsal Routine - Outdoors**

- If need to grab something from Auditorium, enter using back stage doors.
- Use hand sanitizer before rehearsal and after placing reed/mouthpiece on instrument
- WW/Brass wear masks fully when not playing; perc. wear masks throughout reh.
- Avoid touching face
- Bring instrument, stand, music to South side of HS
- Maintain 6 feet or more of social distancing.
- After rehearsal, use hand sanitizer after instrument is packed up
- WW's/Brass spray sanitize your mouthpiece/reed
- Percussion wipe down/sanitize any shared equipment
- Re-enter the building through East side Auditorium doors
- Place instruments in designated Aud. seats
- Exit Auditorium though hallway side or back of auditorium doors.

**School Day Rehearsal Routine - Indoors**

\*Same as outdoor rehearsals, except:

- Enter Auditorium through back stage doors. .
- Go directly to your assigned row/seats and remain there during rehearsal.
- Avoid touching other students' seats or equipment
- Exit Auditorium through hallway side or back of auditorium doors.

\*Bring instruments home at the end of the day and back again for your next rehearsal.

(excluding Bari-Sax, Sousaphones, Percussion)

\*Percussionists need to use own SD sticks, Marimba/Susp. Cym mallets, & Timpani mallets

-use an electronic tuner on phone to tune timpani (no shared pitch pipes)
